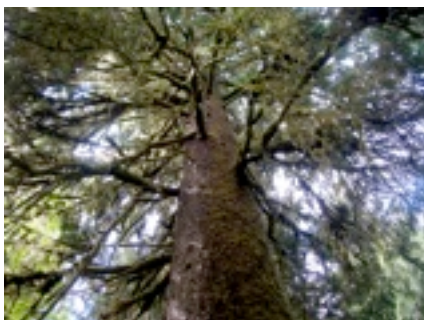

### Directions:

Head west from the ferry terminal towards Queen Charlotte and pass Martynuik road on the right. The next road on the left (ocean side) is the lane for Hideaway Cabin. To identify the lane, across from it on the inland side is Eagle hill road.

### From the VIC:

Head east out of town, turn right at the lane way across from Eagle hill road on the ocean side.

### While you stay at Hideaway cabin:

- no smoking in cabin
- no pets in cabin, dog house is outside
- only burn firewood provided for wood stove, do not burn garbage indoors
- shut down fireplace when you leave
- do not put t.p. in toilet unless soiled, t.p. must be biodegradable
- drinking water is provided in bottles, tap water is for other use
- to heat water, use wood fireplace or a pot and hot plate
- outdoor camping shower is in storage container in bathroom
- no solvents or chemicals in sinks or toilets
- latch screen door, it can catch in the wind
- turn lights off when not in use

### What you can do while you visit:

- swim on the beach
- enjoy a campfire outside
- see local gift shops and galleries (art route brochure)
- kayaking, hiking and fishing
- visit Haida Gwaii museum in Skidegate
